

Roger Bacon High School Visual Art Scholarship Rules



Roger Bacon High School Freshman Art Scholarship for the 2012—2013 School Year

Official Rules:

- ◆ Only current eighth grade students are eligible.
- ◆ Three scholarships will be awarded for the 2012- 2013 school year, which will be applied to freshman tuition only. The amounts are **\$1500, \$1000, \$500**.
- ◆ In order to enter the competition, applicants must complete the following portfolio of works by **December 9, 2011**:
 - ◆ A self-portrait: head and shoulders or full body done in pencil or ink.
 - ◆ A pencil drawing of a shoe
 - ◆ Using a circle, a square or triangle – or any combination of these shapes – vary the width and height and arrange them into an abstract composition. Choose two, three or four colors and color all shapes.
 - ◆ A drawing, fully rendered and shaded, of a clear drinking glass with water and a straw if available.
 - ◆ A drawing of a crumpled brown paper bag.
- ◆ Applicants must bring the above portfolio and a complete application to the main office at Roger Bacon High School on or before December 9, 2011. Paper clip or place everything in a folder/portfolio.
- ◆ Applicants are responsible for picking up their portfolios at Roger Bacon High School. Portfolios should be picked up on January 6, 2012 in the main office of Roger Bacon High School.
- ◆ Winners must **register to attend Roger Bacon** for the 2012-2013 school year and **must schedule art for their freshman year**. It is strongly recommended the student take at least one art course each of the following school years.
- ◆ The Judges' decision of winners is final.
- ◆ Only the winners will be notified in January
